

GUATEMALA MISSION TRIP – JULY 24-30, 2017

COST \$1250 (which includes airline ticket, all living accommodations, travel expenses, and mission project work supplies).

All other individual expenses (gifts, tourism, etc. is a responsibility of the individual)

DUE DATES:

1. Applications Due **Sunday, March 26, 2017** (earlier is preferred)
 - \$150.00 Deposit due (All deposits are refundable until airline tickets are purchased, if you are not selected for the trip or elect to not go).
 - Parental Permission Form (for youth)
 - Copy of Passport or copy of Passport Application
2. 2017 Guatemala Team (Target of no more than 15 team members)
3. **Sunday, April 23, 2017** \$750.00 Due
4. **Sunday, May 21, 2017** – Remaining Balance Due: (For total of \$1250.00)

*Financial assistance from CBC may be available, on a limited basis, but not to exceed 1/3 of individual trip costs.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MISSION TRIP PARTICIPATION

Have an up-to-date Passport – make sure it will not expire within 6 months of the start date of the mission trip. **IF you do not have a Passport - apply NOW!

Turn in Mission Trip Application, Copy of Passport, (or order yours NOW) by required date to Rusty Gosz or Andy Logan directly or turn into the church office, no later than April 23, 2017.

Sample ITINERARY (from a previous year)

MONDAY

- *Arrive at Aurora Airport in Guatemala City and travel to Antigua (This is a 1 1/2 hour journey). We will rent one van in addition to the Jeremiah Project Van.
- CBC Approved Drivers will be (Rusty Gosz and Andy Logan, in addition to Nancy and Josue)
- *Check into our hotel (Villa Del Marques) and relax from the day's travel or explore Antigua Market area in set groups with group leaders.
- * Orientation, welcome and planning meeting at hotel
- * Dinner
- * Worship and Meeting study time

TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY (Heavy work days)

- *Breakfast together
- *Small Group Study Time
- *Morning devotions led by a group member
- *Address plan for the day and leave out for project work (PROJECT WORK i.e. CBS and Home Visits. Prep supplies and PPJ lunch prep teams.
- * Travel to work site with lunch at work site and Jeremiah Project
- * Leave worksite for hotel (typically between 4 pm and 5 pm)
- *Dinner together
- *Worship and Meeting study time
- * Evening gathering with worship time and closing reflection on the trip

FRIDAY

- *Breakfast together
- *Small Group Study Time
- *Morning devotions led by a group member
- *Address plan for the day and leave out for project work (PROJECT WORK i.e. CBS and Home Visits. Prep supplies and PPJ lunch prep teams.
- * Travel to work site with lunch at work site and Jeremiah Project
- * Leave worksite for hotel (typically between 4 pm and 5 pm)
- *Dinner together
- *Worship and Meeting study time

SATURDAY

- *This is a day that could involve both work and play. Project work in the morning and a fun activity and or trip in the afternoon/evening (Volcano trip, Lake trip, Ocean trip, Etc.)
- *Breakfast together
- *Dinner together
- *Evening worship and reflections
- Special NOTE: weekend meal may be on our own out of the hotel as the cooking staff will have some time off from taking care of us.

SUNDAY

- *Breakfast together
- *Morning devotion time
- *Travel to Aurora Airport in Guatemala City for departure. You should arrive at the airport at least 2 ½ hours before your departure.
